In order to start receiving your bill by email again you must sign up through the customer portal

<https://chenoail.authoritypay.com/>.

Even if you had received your bill by email you must sign up again as this is a whole new system. You will need your CID number and NEW account number located on your latest bill. You can call City Hall to obtain those as well.

The pay online option is not yet set up. We have been working very hard on getting that on the portal and hopefully will be on there by the end of the month.

Julia Green Scott married Matthew T. Scott of Lexington, Kentucky on May 12, 1859. She met Matthew while he was attending Centre College. Her father had been the president there since 1855. Together they moved to the Central Illinois prairie where they were among the first residents and founders of the town of Chenoa. However, Chenoa did not prosper as the boomtown the Scotts had envisioned. They moved to Springfield in 1870 publicly because of Julia's health, but it's more likely that they moved because Julia was unhappy with Chenoa society.
